

The Harley & Michele O'Neil New Student Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to provide scholarships for newly enrolled Shoreline Community College in need of financial assistance. Students who need assistance of \$2,000 or less are invited to apply. **Students may receive only one scholarship award per academic year. Priority is given to new students of Shoreline Community College, although current students may apply.**

Scholarship is for Shoreline Community College tuition and fees related to tuition, and/or required books and materials, parking permits, and/or bus passes. This award has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Priority is given to new students of Shoreline Community College (applies within first quarter). Current students will be considered and may apply.
- Max request must be \$2,000 or under and must be used within the current academic year.
- Be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **one collated packet** and in order. Please do not include this application page. Packet should include the following:

1. Completed Application
2. Response to two short essay questions (responses can be turned in on a separate sheet of paper)
3. Budget Worksheet

The application is reviewed by Harley and Michele O'Neil.

The applicant will be notified of the decision within a week of the application being submitted, if submitted during an academic session. Breaks during winter, spring and summer do not count as part of the one-week notification time.
